UMPIRES CORNER

Umpires, markers and measurers are an essential part of all bowling clubs, for championship games, social bowls and pennant games. Becoming an Umpire, Marker or Measurer in bowls is an option available to all bowlers with a just few years of experience.

We have only four umpires at Eltham presently and the club would like at least three or four more. The duties involved (mostly measuring) are not onerous and can be quite satisfying and enjoyable to carry out. You also do not have to memorise all the rules, just have a clear understanding of the basic rules and where to find them in the rule book. There is now even an iphone app to refer to all rules.

Umpires and measurers will only get about 2 or 3 duty games per month (only home games) if we have about 8 qualified measurers. And it is usually very rare that you would get a call to measure or adjudicate. But never the less we do need the numbers.





Should you take this on then as you progress through the Umpiring Accreditation process, as well as gaining valuable skills and experience, you will have the opportunity to officiate at state, national and even international events. Getting the Accreditation is really quite simple and we can help you with all the skills at the club beforehand.

All the information and resources on how to become an accredited umpire over three accreditation levels linked to specific roles within officiating the game, namely those of Marker, Measurer and National Umpire can be found on the following Vic Bowls website: http://www.bowlsvic.org.au/Participation/Umpiring

Rule change for the use of Bowler's Arms in a game:

BA Directors supported the proposal that a player using a bowling arm may decide whether they also use the bowling arm to deliver the jack.

The relevant section of the BA Artificial Devices Policy will be amended as follows; the change is highlighted:

5.1.8 The bowlers arm once used in a game must be used for the remainder of the game. This does not apply to the rolling of the jack, which can rolled either by hand or by a bowlers arm.

BA will shortly be publishing a revised Artificial Devices Policy on the BA Website.


