We arrived at our accommodation in North Adelaide early afternoon, then went to the Tranmere Bowling Club, the host club for this event, where we caught up with the rest of our squad members who had driven across. 

Victoria only had to win three of the remaining twelve games on **Day 4** to retain the title for the seventh year of in a row. We won four games in the morning and four in the afternoon to win the title by 19 points.

Within the comp, each state also plays the other for a state shield. *Victoria had a clean slate this year, taking out all 5 state shields and of course the big one.*


